Central Bank of Ireland Issues Warning on Unauthorised Firm – Appletrade Ltd

23 May 2022 Warning Notice



It has come to the attention of the Central Bank of Ireland ('Central Bank') that Appletrade Ltd (Ireland) - <u>www.appletrade.de</u> (no longer operational) has been operating as an investment firm / investment business firm in the State in the absence of appropriate authorisations. A list of unauthorised firms published to date is available on the Central Bank <u>website</u>. It is a criminal offence for an unauthorised firm to provide financial services in Ireland that would require an authorisation under the relevant legislation for which the Central Bank is the responsible body for enforcing. Consumers should be aware, that if they deal with a firm that is not authorised, they are not eligible for compensation from the Investor Compensation Scheme.
