

The *Commissione Nazionale per le Società e la Borsa* (CONSOB) has ordered the black-out of **3 new websites** that offer financial products/services illegally.

The Authority availed itself of the powers deriving from the “Decreto crescita” (growth decree, Law no. 58 of 28 June 2019, article 36, paragraph 2-*terdecies*) regarding the blackout of the sites of abusive financial intermediaries, as well as the power introduced by Law no. 8 of 28 February 2020 (article 4, paragraph 3-*bis*), regarding the blackout of the sites through which the abusive offer is made.

Below are the sites Consob has ordered to be blacked out:

- **Fti Finance** (website <https://www.ftifinance.net>);
- **Broker Capitals Limited** (website <https://brokercapitals.com> and its page <https://platform.brokercapitals.com>).
- **Mb Invest** (website [www.investingmb.com](http://www.investingmb.com)).

The black-out of these websites by internet service providers operating on Italian territory is ongoing. For technical reasons, it can take several days for the black-out to come into effect.
